School of Creative Learning

SCHOOL OF CREATIVE LEARNING is an innovative school run by APCL (Association for Promotion of Creative Learning), a non-profit making organisation registered under Societies Registration Act, 1860. It has been established with the objective of promoting creative learning in society. It has developed a unique teaching learning methodology, based on our age old Indian learning system properly blended with modern learning technology, to promote Quality Education in society. It believes that the problems of our society in new millennium, can be solved only by universalising Quality Education.

It is affiliated to CBSE. However, it teaches syllabi with additional special inputs on development of **Concentration, Memory, Thinking, Imagination, Power of observation, Emotional Management, and Managerial Abilities**. It has now been scientifically established that about 90% of the development of brain is complete before 5 years of age. So, if a child is not given these inputs in early years, he may not attain his full potential ever in life. Hence, these additional inputs are started right from Nursery level. It also prepares children to fare better in the competitive examination after completing School education, so that they may not have to rush to any coaching institute for development of such competencies. It also prepares them better for self employment through business and industries which is going to be the major source of employment in the competitive open market today. It has developed a large number of teaching learning materials, which has gained appreciation all over the country.

The school is run and managed by Association for Promotion of Creative learning, which is a society promoted by alumni of Netarhat School.

Its teaching methodology based on development of both right and left brain, which combines ancient Yogic Methods of Indian Teaching with modern teaching of West. It develops joyful Method of teaching. To make learning interesting songs, drama, games, Magic, etc are also used to teach Mathematics, Science, Social Sciences and language.

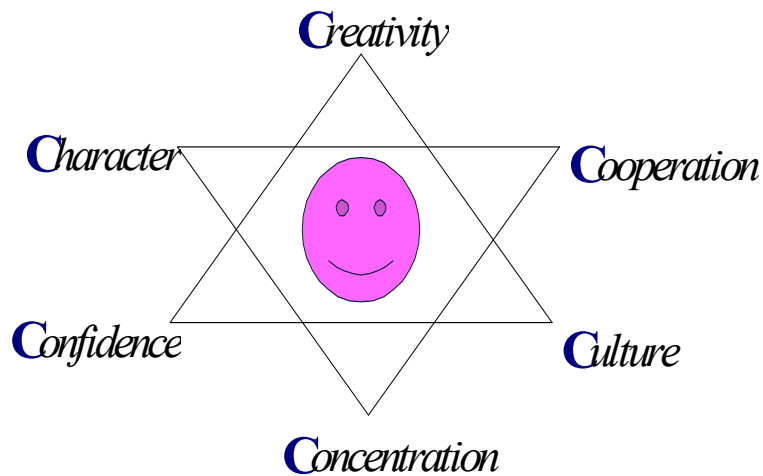
